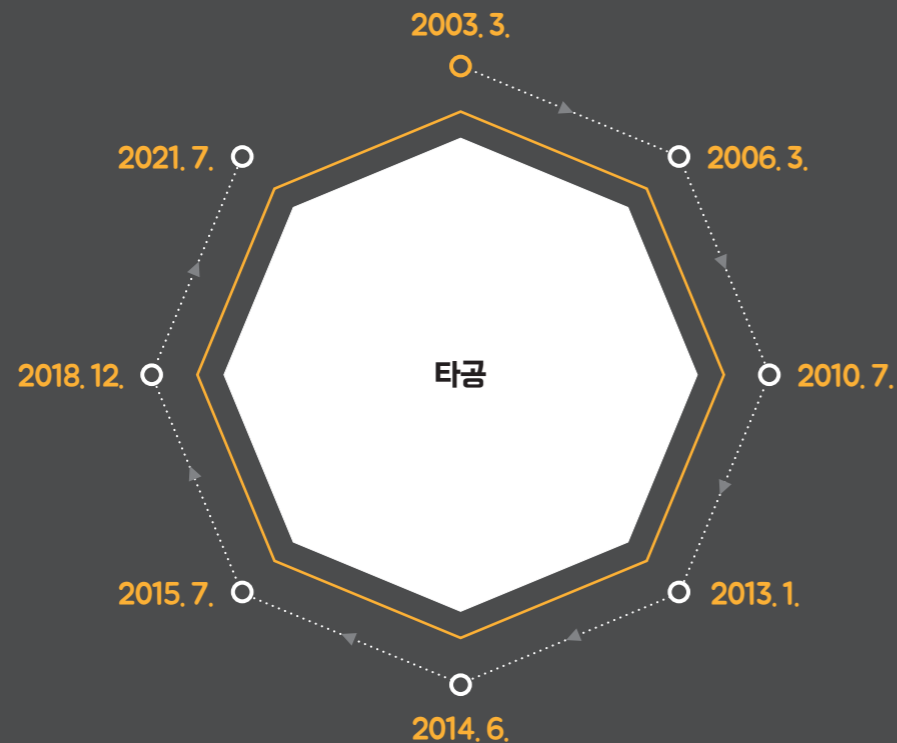

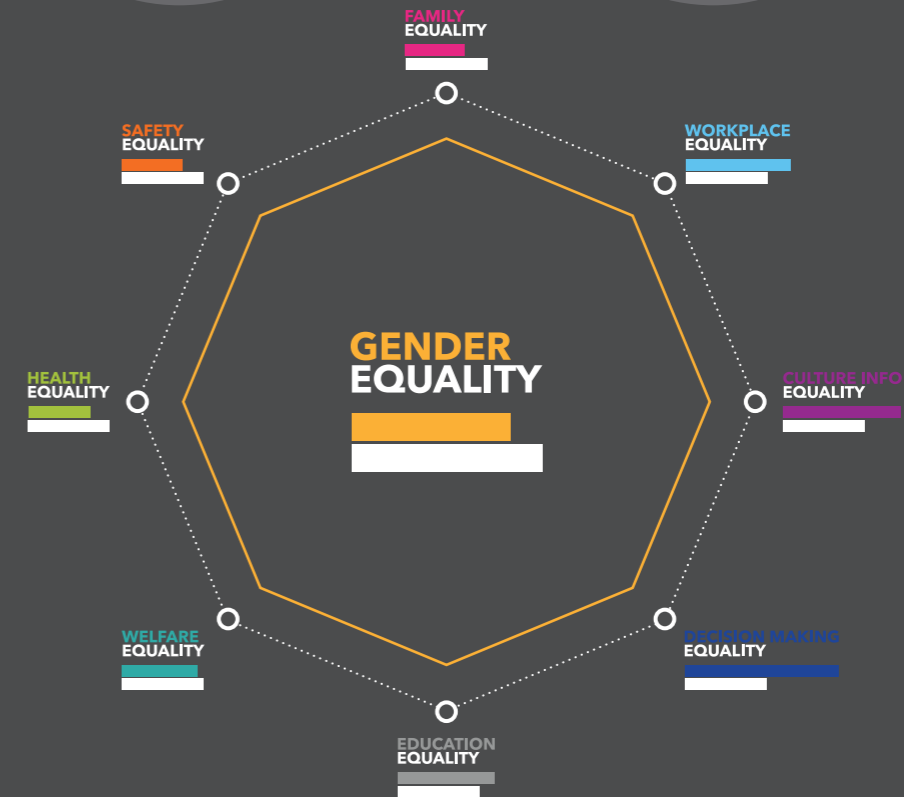

This program aims to improve the gender awareness and spread gender equality culture across the society through developing a pool of specialists including trainers, who plan and execute gender-based violence prevention education covering sexual violence, sexual harassment, sex trafficking, and domestic violence. We also train counsellors specializing in sexual harassment and sexual violence, who play a critical role for sexual harassment and sexual violence preventive measures of public institutes.



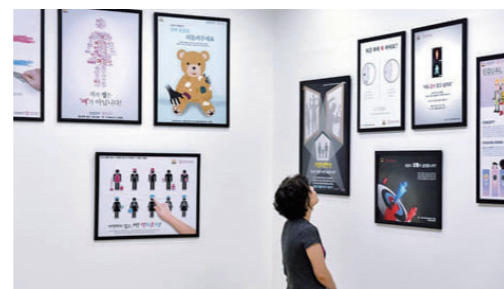

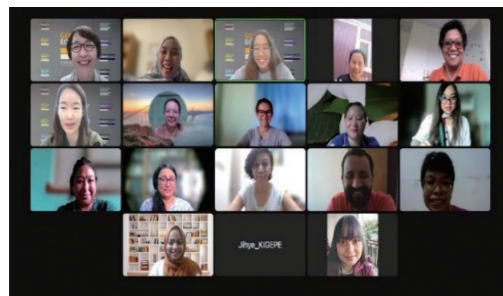

Project International exchanges & education

The Asian Gender Trainers' Network Program (AGenT)

- AGenT provides gender training sessions for capacity building of trainers, targeting gender trainers from 21 Asian countries (local NGOs, international NGOs, social enterprises, and academia).
- AGenT provides Training of Trainers (TOT), which employs a participatory approach based on the Asian societal and cultural context.

AGenT: Asian Gender Trainers' Network Program

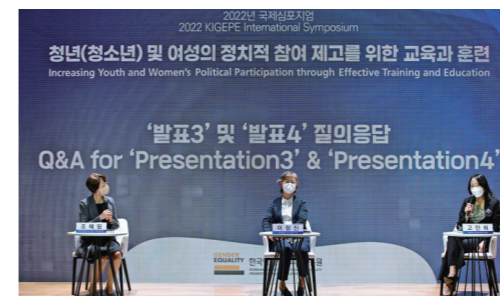

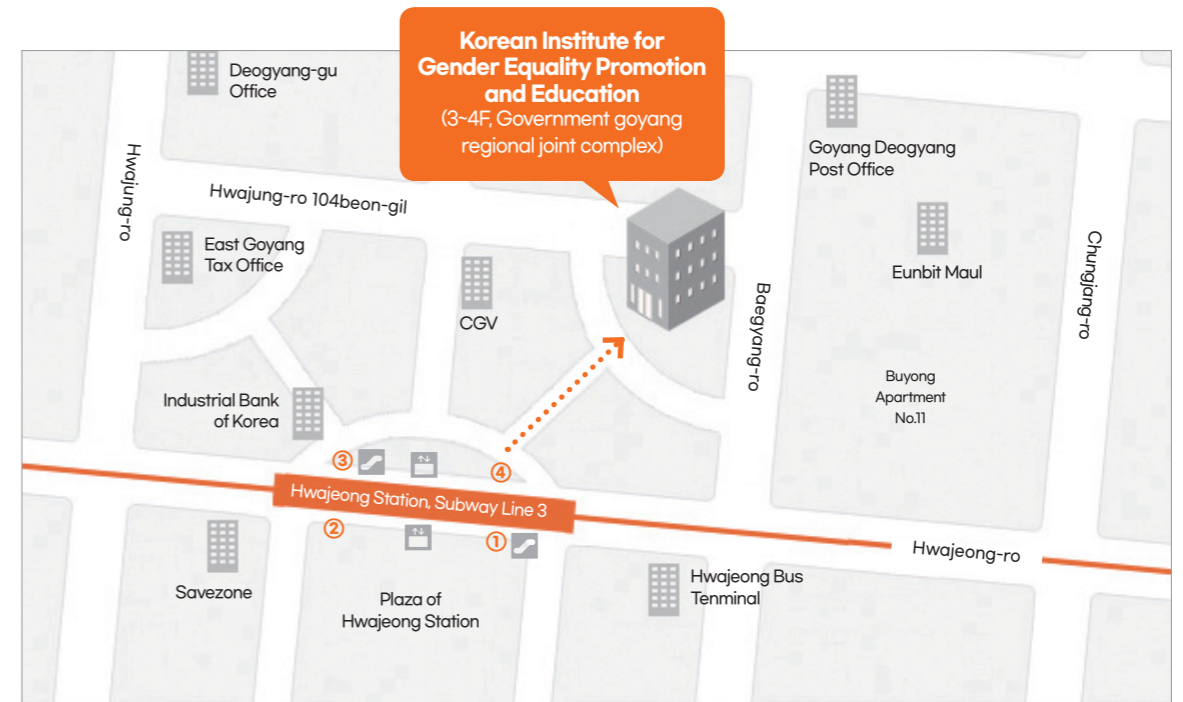
